**Pick Up Work:** Next rotation drop-off

**THEME:** *Singing the Blues* -- Let your imagination take it to the next level. This can be in the way of using the color blue as the primary theme in your work; feeling or being blue; interpreting music about being blue or the "blues" itself -- this is a wide interpretation of the "blue" theme.

**LOCATION OF EXHIBIT:** ArtHub, 107 West Pearl St, Nashua, NH

**ELIGIBILITY:** *Open to NAAA members only.* Only original work by the artist will be allowed. If the work in question does not reflect the artist's personal style as demonstrated by their body of work, then the validity of the work being "original" needs to come into question. Work completed from a reference piece provided by an instructor is not considered original. Student work done under the supervision of an instructor will not be accepted. NAAA reserves the right to reject any work that does not fit the theme of the show, as well as work that does not conform to the standards of good taste or suitability for public viewing.

**WORK REQUIREMENTS:** All artwork must be professionally presented. **2D work must be wired. No saw tooth or keyhole hangers will be accepted for this exhibition. "Easel" style frames designed for tabletop use will not be accepted, even if wired.** Failure to meet the hanging requirements will result in your work being rejected for this exhibition. A guideline will be posted on the website.

**Please Note:** Exhibition space is limited. Artwork will be displayed as space limitations allow. The artists will be contacted to pick up any work we are unable to display.

**VOLUNTEER REQUIREMENTS:** A reminder that members of NAAA are required to sign up to gallery sit. If you have not signed up electronically prior to drop-off, you must sign up at time of drop-off in order for your work to be accepted. No exceptions.

**INVENTORY SHEETS:** Please download, print, and fill out the Inventory Sheet. Please email a copy of your inventory sheet to Maddie LaRose ([mplarose@gmail.com](mailto:mplarose@gmail.com)) so that labels can be made in time for hanging. ALSO, remember to bring it, already completed, when dropping off your work. See the NAAA website for more details: [www.nashuaarts.org](http://www.nashuaarts.org).

**ARTIST CONTRACT:** A signed and completed artist contract is required for displaying work with the Nashua Area Artists' Association. Please download, print, and complete the contract from the NAAA web site: [www.nashuaarts.org](http://www.nashuaarts.org). Remember to bring it with you at time of drop-off. The contract is good for one calendar year and must be filled out by all artists.

**SALES:** NAAA will take standard 30% commission as cited in the NAAA artist contract on all sales of artwork. All works submitted to the show must be for sale.

\* Please make every effort to make arrangements to pick up your work during the scheduled pick up times. Unless prior arrangements have been made, work left beyond the pick-up date will be subject to a \$5 per business day holding fee. Work left 30 days beyond the pick-up date will be considered abandoned and will become the property of the NAAA.
